Subject: Excavation

To Whom It May Concern:

McGuire and Hester along with several Subcontractors is about to begin a major excavation as part of the Leland Avenue Streetscape Improvement Project. This project was recently awarded to McGuire and Hester by the City and County of San Francisco's Department of Public Works (DPW).

The work includes installation of a new sewer main and street improvements on Leland Avenue from Bayshore Boulevard through the intersection of Rutland Street. The first order of work is the new sewer system which is anticipated to take approximately six weeks and is planned to start on August 31, 2009. The street improvements will follow after that and will be completed within 10-months from the projects notice to proceed. M&H will not work from Thanksgiving through New Years Day due to a moratorium.

While the work will necessarily cause some inconvenience to the public, it is M&H's intent to be good neighbors and be as unobtrusive as possible.
